



# Magnetic Alphabet Games

For the little ones

## FEATURE SORT

Sort your letters in a variety of ways - e.g. letters with long sticks and letters with short sticks, letters with circles and letters with no circles, letters with tunnels and letters with dots, letters with slanted sticks and letters with straight sticks.

## COLOR SORT

Sort all the different colors of the letters.

## MAKING NAMES

Make your name with the letters. Mix them up and do it again. Check it with your name your parents have written on a card.

## LETTER MATCH

Find other letters that look exactly the same as a letter in your name (e.g. place an m on the a baking tray and then find all the ones that look like it).

## ALPHABET SOUP

Place all the letters in a large bowl. Stir the letters with a mixing spoon and spoon out one letter. See if you can identify which letter it is and what sound it makes!



# Magnetic Alphabet Games

For the older ones

## ALPHABETICAL ORDER

Put your set of lowercase letters in correct alphabetical order. Then do the same with your uppercase letters.

## UPPERCASE/LOWERCASE MATCH

Match all your uppercase letters with their lowercase form.

## NAME GAME

Make your name and the names of your friends or family. Mix up your letters, and make the names again.

## FIND THE LETTER

Make a set of alphabet letters, upper or lowercase, on a set of index cards. Shuffle the "deck" and take turns drawing a card and finding the magnetic letter that corresponds to it.

## CHANGING VOWELS

Have a parent make a three-letter word for you. Change the vowel to make a new word (for example, cat, cut, cot; hop, hip; hat, hit, hot, hut).

## CROSSWORD LETTERS

Play with a friend or parent. Make a word and then have your friend add a word that starts from one of the letters. The word can go across or down.
